

Data Processing & Consent — Third Pancreatic Cancer Symposium 2026

What is the GDPR?

The GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) is an EU regulation that protects the personal data and privacy of individuals within the EU. This notice explains how Van Hauen Conferences processes your personal data when you register for the Third Pancreatic Cancer Symposium 2026.

What information do we collect?

When you complete the registration form, we collect: your name, e-mail address, phone number, organisation/hospital, billing address (address, city, postal code, country), and your professional role (doctor, nurse, or patient) if you register as a delegate, or your company's VAT number if you register as an exhibitor/sponsor. We also record which registration or sponsorship package you select and your chosen payment method.

Payment card details are processed directly and securely by our payment provider, Stripe — we do not see or store your card number.

Why do we collect this information?

- To process and confirm your registration
- To generate and send your invoice
- To plan the event (catering, room capacity, attendee list for the organising committee)
- To comply with Danish bookkeeping law, which requires us to retain invoicing records for 5 years
- To send you practical information about the event as it approaches

Sharing your details with exhibitors (optional)

On the registration form you can choose whether we may share your name, hospital and country with the symposium's exhibitors and sponsors, before and after the event. This is entirely optional and does not affect your registration if you decline. You can withdraw this consent at any time by contacting vanhauen@vanhauen.dk.

Who do we share your data with?

We use two data processors to run the registration and payment system:

- **Netlify, Inc.** (USA) — hosts the website and the registration form
- **Stripe, Inc.** (USA) — processes card payments and invoicing

Both are US-based processors and transfer data outside the EU/EEA under the European Commission's Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs), which provide safeguards equivalent to GDPR requirements.

How long do we keep your data?

General registration and contact details are kept for as long as necessary to run the event and handle any follow-up enquiries, after which they are deleted. Invoicing data is retained for 5 years, as required

under Danish bookkeeping law.

Your rights

You have the right to access, correct, or request deletion of your personal data, to restrict or object to our processing of it, and to receive your data in a portable format, subject to the conditions set out in the GDPR. Complaints
